

Dr Gary Tian received his Master of Applied Finance and PhD from Macquarie University in 1994. His main research interests are in the areas of corporate governance, market microstructure, and Chinese financial markets. He has published 32 refereed articles in international finance journals, as well as 10 books and book chapters. He has also won 15 internal and external research grants as a chief investigator since 1994, three of which were ARC grants from the Australian Research Council. Dr Tian is currently supervising 8 PhD students, most of these PhD students are funded by Chinese Scholarship Council, other government organisations and various industries.

Gary is now the Director of the Chinese Commerce Research Centre at the University of Wollongong. The Centre has established strong research collaboration with colleagues in other universities, and links with industries and governments. He has also served as the Head of Postgraduate Studies in the School since April 2007. He is responsible for the management and administration of postgraduate research studies, including 50 PhD and Masters by research students and their supervisors in the school.
