STUDENTS from the Singapore Management University will be selling, in the next two weeks, \$2 donation tickets in aid of two social services agencies – En Community Services Society and Bethesda Care & Counselling Service Centre, which looks after underprivileged children.

The 150 students will be at Toa Payoh, Bishan and Ang Mo Kio Hub between Monday and Friday, and at Clementi, Woodlands Central and Jurong Point between July 19 and 22.

The sales will take place from 11am to 9pm.

For the July 25 finale to this fund-raising initiative, dubbed Project Balloons of Bliss, the atrium of Jurong Point Shopping Centre will be decked out with three giant animal sculpture balloons representing the hopes and dreams of young children.

Smaller balloon sculptures will also be sold to raise funds for the two social service centres.
