Undergraduate Supplementary Assistance Plan

(An undergraduate financial assistance scheme under the SMU Resilience Fund)

To help undergraduate students from families (gross monthly household per capita income not exceeding \$500) and whose family members' livelihoods are being adversely affected by the COVID-19 outbreak, SMU has set up the **Undergraduate Supplementary Assistance Plan** providing interim relief to students in need of financial help during this difficult period.

Affected students will each receive a one-off \$500 financial relief. Repayment is not required and is given in addition to regular scholarship, bursary or study awards.

Eligibility Criteria

- All nationalities
- Enrolled in any undergraduate programme
- Gross monthly household per capita income not exceeding \$500
- Family members' livelihoods being adversely affected by the COVID-19 outbreak
- Must have submitted a bursary application for AY2020-21 award
- Must have taken up a form of tuition fees financing scheme (CPF Education Scheme, Tuition Fee Loan, Study Loan) or will be applying to utilise one or a combination of the schemes at the forthcoming window# to pay tuition fees.

In addition,

- students in receipt of scholarships will be included for consideration.
- final year students pending approval for graduation are eligible to be considered.

Applications for tuition fees financing schemes commencing Term 1, A2020-21 will be accepted between May and August (subject to respective scheme's application dates).
